Where Courage Took Flight

In 1947, returning Second World War airmen in London came together to preserve more than memories — they preserved a legacy. What began as a gathering of veterans became 427 (London) Wing, part of a national network dedicated to honouring Canada's aviation story.

During the war years, RCAF Station London trained thousands of aircrew who would go on to serve across the world. The very grounds where the museum stands were once filled with the sound of engines, ambition, and determination.

Today, that legacy lives on — through preserved buildings, memorials, and the stories of the people who shaped the skies.

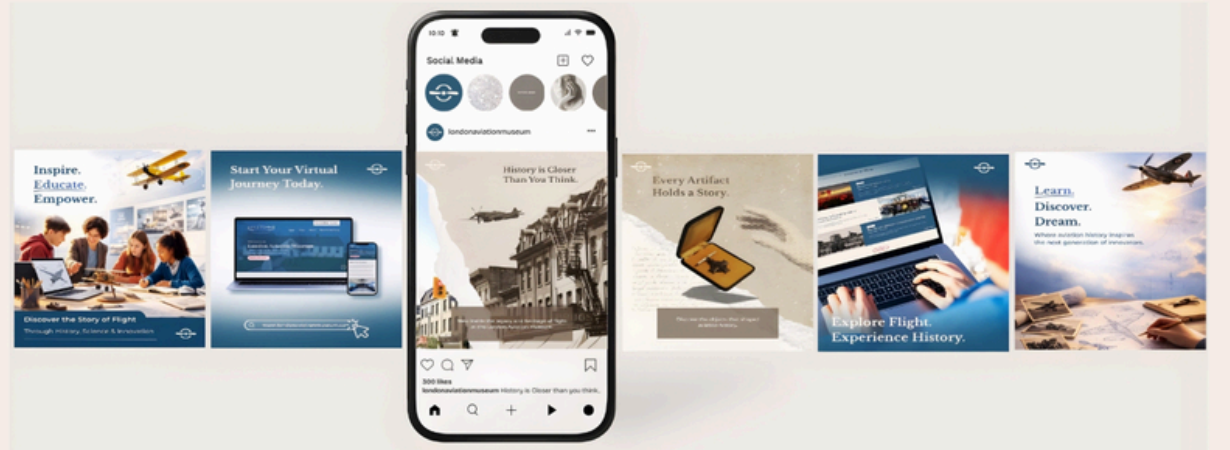
